Following funding from UKRI and the Industrial Strategy Challenge Fund, part of the Transforming Construction Challenge, BPN in partnership with BSi are developing a Building Performance Evaluation British Standard.

Dr Kerry Mashford OBE is chairing the Drafting Panel.

The programme allows for a public consultation which will take place in June and July with publication scheduled for December 2021.
